MH2023 Outcomes We Want to Achieve

MH2023 Solution Expectations

- 1. Solutions are to be aligned with given problem statements only.
- 2. Design on ppt, or, online or physical models, and such can be submitted where solutions are complex. For e.g., Civil Engineering based solutions, expensive technology-based solutions may be shown as diagrams in ppt and as models.
- 3. For software application-based solutions, minimally, UI wireframes are expected. Better to show working prototypes.
- 4. Reuse of existing solutions allowed. However, value additions done by you are to be highlighted.
- 5. Since majority of the Problems are Madurai-centric, Solutions are expected to be specific in nature.

MH2023 Winner Selection Criteria

Criteria	Description
Solution Features	We expect the solution to address the core of the problem. Participants must demonstrate that they have understood the problem clearly. They should be able to elaborate on the core functional and technical features of the given problem and include that in the solution design.
Feasibility	The solution provided is expected to be practical in terms of technical feasibility and adoption. Participants should consider the cost and effort factors also.
User Centricity	Consideration of end-user personas in designing the solution maximizes the effectiveness of the solution for adoption in general. Teams are expected to take this perspective into consideration.
Innovation	Viewing problems from different perspectives, Out-of-box thinking and providing unique solution with own logic and algorithms is encouraged.
Reuse	Reusing existing solutions and building on top of them is very much encouraged. Explore repositories like github and the solutions that are currently used around the world. Are there any existing solutions reused? How effectively reuse is done to bring out the final solution? What are the values added on top the reused component, model, idea?
Clarity in Communications, Presentations	Presentation contents are to be clear, easy to understand and unambiguous: Questions are to be answered with short and relevant answers. You can use Tamil and English liberally in all forms of communications.
Identification of Go-To- Market Strategy	In order to implement the solution for effective use, next steps in terms of development of features, testing, business planning, etc., are to be identified and articulated as part of Judges evaluation.

MH2023 – Facilities in the venue



Food & Beverages, water will be provided by the organizers.



Attendance procedure will be announced at the event start. It is mandatory to attend all the scheduled activities.



Bring your own laptops and other models, tools, etc., that you may need to demonstrate your solution. Install required software prior to coming to the offline event.



Electrical power points will be available for mobile and laptop charging. Indian round pin plug point will be available. If you need any specific power plug adapter, bring it on your own. Electrical Power points will need to be shared. Bring extension boxes if available with you.





WiFi will be available. Congestion may be there. You are encouraged to use your own WiFi connection facility (WiFi dongles, mobile phone based) also.

MH2023: Arriving on the Event Day

Ensure you have all these packed:

MH2023: Event Day at TCE campus

- You are expected to arrive at the Open Air Auditorium, TCE for breakfast and get entry kits at 8.00AM.
- The Inauguration ceremony takes place at K.S. Auditorium(closer to registration desk) which is mandatory for you to attend.
- Hackathon takes place in the IT Department. Each team will be allocated a lab which will be mentioned during your registration.

MH2023: TCE campus – Do's and Don't's

- 1. You will have to sit in the assigned Labs which will be intimated at the registration.
- 2. Formal College Dress Code must be followed [formal shirt and pant for Boys and Chudithar with shawl for Girls].
- 3. You must wear your MH2023 ID Card always.
